



A LONG TIME AGO.. IN A GALAXY FAR AWAY...

All business owners became regulated:

• **Donohue v Stevenson 1932** – The neighbour Principle adopted into English Tort law and Scots Delict law

 Sales of Goods Act 1979 - Harlington & Leinster v Christopher Hull Fine Art [1991] 1 QB 564





YOU ARE ALREADY REGULATED

• Employment Act 1995 - Vento v Chief Constable of West Yorkshire Police (No.2) (20 December 2002)



• Equality Act 2010 - WR (on the application of Unison) v Lord Chancellor (Supreme Court, 26 July 2017)





SO WHAT?

Without the law (whether we agree with it or not.....)

- No mechanism to redress a business or person who causes us harm, perceived or not
- No way of getting our money back if we do not receive the product or service expected
- No further avenue to explore if the business or person dismisses your grievance
- No Impartial body to take emotion out of the situation and look at what is the issue, what is the rule for issue and how should that have been applied – what is the result?



YOU SHOULD EXPECT THE SAME FROM YOUR CERTIFICATION BODY

"UKAS is the National Accreditation Body for the United Kingdom. We are appointed by government, to assess and accredit organisations that provide services including certification, testing, inspection and calibration." <u>UKAS - The UK Accreditation Body - Creating Confidence – UKAS</u>

There is also global mutual recognition through the International Accreditation Forum

WHY IS THE LOGO IMPORTANT?


- The NQA logo is subject to copyright, this is monitored by myself, non-certified businesses using this are contacted and action is pursued
- This automatically tells your associates from your certificate that your system is certified by a reputable and regulated government body
- It also tells your customers you have invested in certification and because this means a higher cost – you probably take it seriously



- Your company certification can be checked by using UKAS website to verify your certificate is genuine
- Should you be unhappy with how your certification body has managed a complaint, you can complain directly to UKAS

THE FINAL QUESTION

Yes accredited certification bodies cost more – we also pay A LOT to be accredited, not only the

- That possibly has not had confidence to pay for the external validation


