- When I conduct audits & document review, do I have to make it more complicated or easier for my company?
- Are we already meeting the points/clauses of the standard?



# **Core Benefits - Examples**

## **Perceived Negatives**

- 1) This is going to be too time consuming!
- We don't have enough employees to monitor this!
- 3) How are we going to monitor this?
- 4) Investigations are too difficult to complete, if its wrong, its wrong

### **Perceived Positives**

- 1) Attaching a certificate to a tender application is going to be so much simpler than all of those documents.
- 2) We're already doing most of this as part of our daily duties
- 3) Our inspections are just like internal audits when we're making a product.
- 4) Using a common standard means our clients know we strive to improve.
- 5) Larger companies & governmental departments eg. DoT, require any potential supplier to hold ISO certification.



### **Potential Pitfalls**

- Not realising the importance of checking checklists during production. Internal audits are a check on what you are doing. These can be procedural audits or process audits aka vertical audits.
- Not realising that recording meetings, changes to processes, tweaks to a system can help you not hinder you.
- 3) Understanding that approval lists can make a task easier for example approved suppliers – removing a company from the list, enables you to record bad service, substandard products (if you have specifications), wrong products being delivered, etc.
- Management review this part of the standard is possibly the only prescriptive clause it gives you the topics for the meeting



### CONCLUSION

- ISO 9001:2015 is not as complicated at it initially seems
- The 2015 version is more user friendly than previous versions ISO wanted it to be more encompassing and to enable smaller companies the belief that they could get certification. Although the new version is to be issued in September 2025.
- It is possible to keep it simple, there is no need to over complicate things.



### **SUMMARY OF LEARNINGS**

- What are the Core Benefits of ISO 9001:2015
- Approved Suppliers understanding that just because you have always used a particular supplier this may not be the best for the business.
- Tender Applications most business sectors have a tender application process that they use to determine who their list of top suppliers are.
- Formalising the existing system you were already addressing the clauses of the standard but just had not had either an internal or external check (audit) to illustrate that you were.
