

CONTEXT

- Supply chains can be fragile
- Customers and markets change
- It's not a level playing field
- High risk contracts are house of cards
- Shortage of supply chain expertise
- Inventory can be vulnerable
- Markets don't behave rationally
- Supply chain management is changing



IDENTIFYING A SUPPLIER IN DISTRESS






SUPPLIER SEGMENTATION

- Confirm and apply value/criticality factors
- Establish supplier priority after due diligence

- Establish in–life assurance requirements
- Determine Total Cost of Ownership precontract



Supply chain risk / criticality




RISK ASSESSMENT

 We can assess risk at various levels of complexity.

 Once a risk has been identified, we need to assess several elements, including:

- Impact
- Likelihood
- Proximity
- Timescale
- Controls
- Key Risk Indicators
- Response mechanism and plan
- Accountability






SUPPLIER ASSURANCE MONITORING

The 'Three Lines' of defence approach:

Reliance on:

- 'Eyes and ears' on the ground, proactive supplier management
- Availability of external intelligence, e.g. credit risk, adverse media
- Consistent approach to risk control and assurance
- Visibility of risks across the organisation, e.g. using ERM software
- Ownership, ownership, ownership.



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SUMMARY



RISK MITIGATION STRATEGIES

STRATEGIC

- Create and implement a BCP
- Review the sourcing strategy
- Increase supplier conversations
- Near-shore and on-shore
- Regional spread
- Stockpile
- Postpone or delay plans.

TACTICAL

- Contracts with KPIs
- Only use certified suppliers
- Use questionnaires effectively
- Conduct audits
- Online supplier performance research
- Operate a Plan-Do-Check-Act framework
- Heat maps.
